


I'm pleased and excited to share that our Building a Beautiful Church for Mary Capital Campaign is progressing well. The hard work of our volunteers and the sacrifice of parishioners is paying dividends for our faith community. As of today, we total \$929,545 in campaign gifts and pledges. Thank you to our generous donors. It's humbling to receive your sacrifice. I pray that those families who continue to reflect upon their gift, will soon come on board and push us to the \$1 million milestone and beyond!

As you may recall, in late September we mailed a case statement and gift request letter to every registered parish household. We designated some families to receive a follow up call from volunteers, while encouraging others to mail in their commitment. In the weeks since, campaign volunteers have worked to arrange meetings with many to discuss the campaign, answer questions, and finalize pledge commitments. Many parishioners who received a pledge card, completed it and returned it to the parish office.

Whatever group you fall into, please work to submit your pledge over the next two weeks. We are eager to meet and exceed our \$2.5 million goal, but we need everyone in the parish to contribute at whatever level is sacrificial to them. We have accomplished a lot in this campaign with a participation rate of less than 10 percent. Imagine what we'll accomplish if every family defines a gift that is sacrificial and meaningful.
