WEDNESDAY - July 3 - St. Irenaeus of Lyons, Bishop and Martyr III Class Red

Born in Asia Minor around 140, he succeeded the martyred bishop, St. Pothinus, to the diocese of Lyons in 177. He reigned 25 years until he met his martyrdom under a new persecution. At the time when the Gnostic sects threatened to undermine Christianity by a perversion of Christian thought and claiming to possess a sort of secret knowledge of divine revelation, St. Irenaeus vigorously denounced all heresies and safeguarded unity of belief by laying down the doctrinal tradition of the Church.

FRIDAY - July 5 - St. Anthony Mary Zaccaria, Confessor - III Class White

Founder of the Clerks of St. Paul, later called the Barnabites from the name of their principal church in Rome, St. Anthony-Mary was a great admirer of St. Paul and was himself imbued with the teaching of the great Apostle, whom he gave to his followers as a model and patron. He also had a great devotion to the Holy Eucharist. He was an indefatigable preacher and wore himself out in this work. He died on July 5, 1539 at the age of 36.

Born to a peasant family in Italy, on July 6, 1902, at 12 years of age, solicited to sin, she preferred to be stabbed to death rather than lose her virginity. She died pardoning her murderer and praying for his conversion, which she obtained. She was canonized in 1950 by Pope Pius XII, with her own elderly mother and murderer in attendance.
