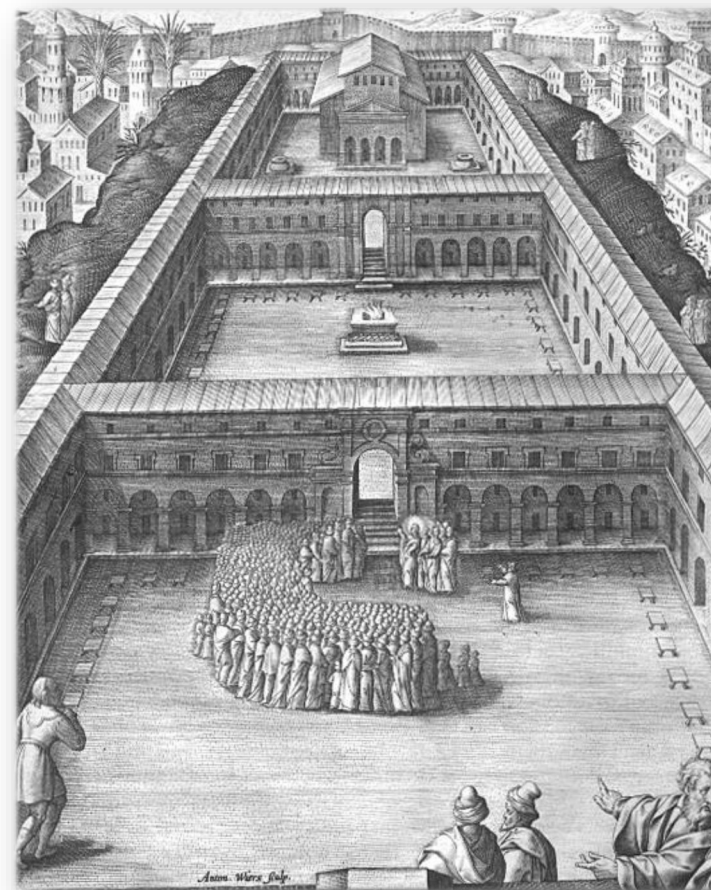

Skirts and Pants:

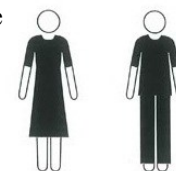
Should cover knee when seated, no slit above the knee
