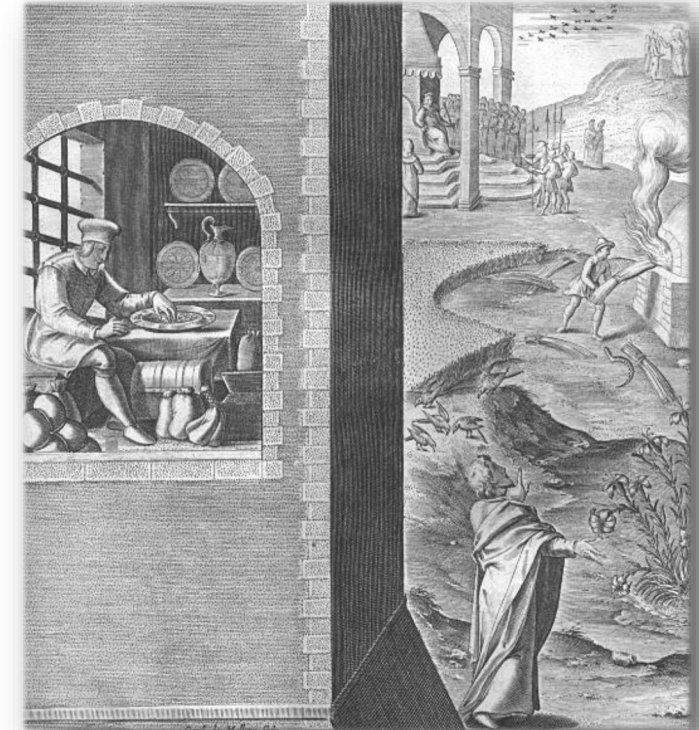

 It will not replace the Adult Catechism Class, but will be meeting  
 at the same time in a different room.

**Mater Dei Dress Code**

*To help facilitate the spirit of prayer and recollection, and  
 in charity to God and neighbor, please respect the  
 following dress code at Mater Dei:*

**Both men and women** - All dress should be clean and  
 neat according to one's means, and modest.  
 Casual clothes should be avoided as regular Mass  
 attire (shorts, athletic shoes, etc.).

On weekdays, one does not have to be quite as  
 formally dressed, and for those going to or from work,  
 exceptions are understandable, but one's clothing should still  
 reflect modesty and reverence.

**Men** - Either a button down shirt or a pullover shirt with a collar,  
 and neat and clean pants; Men should consider wearing a tie to  
 Church and in cooler weather, a suit coat.

**Women** - Clothes that are not tight-fitting.  
 No see-through or revealing material such as sheer fabric or lace  
 as the only layer (except for head coverings of course). Modest  
 necklines (no low-cut, plunging or deep-scoop). Shoulders  
 covered and 1/4 length sleeves. Skirts should cover the knee  
 when seated; no slit above the knee.
