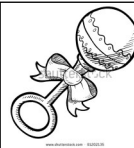
Second Annual Mater Dei Christmas Pageant!!

Men: No shorts or t-shirts.

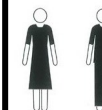
Women: Keep a modest cut neckline
