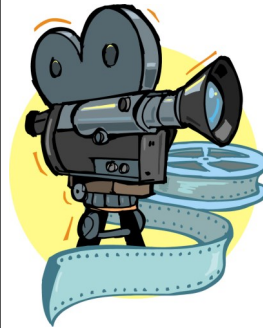

At 7 pm on Jan. 30th, Mater Dei will provide a viewing in the parish hall of a new documentary film on the life of Servant-of-God Dr. Jerome Lejeune. He is known as the Father of Modern Genetics and is most famous for his discovery of the cause of Down Syndrome. He was the first president of the Pontifical Academy for Life, established by Pope John Paul II in 1994. His cause for beatification was started in 2007. 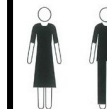
Please respect the Mater Dei dress code
