Beginning March 13th, we are conducting a “comprehensive planning study,” with an eye towards building bigger and better facilities for the parish. Before making any final decisions, regarding the development plan for Mater Dei, I would like to hear from you. I ask you to please participate. In the course of this study, you will all be asked to share your thoughts regarding our needs and the possibility of conducting a fundraising campaign. Your feedback will enable us to determine potential support for the projects. Specifically, the plan will help us determine:

- If there is sufficient support to move forward with a major fundraiser.
- Whether we go ahead all at once, or in phases.
- Do we get everything done, or just some of it?
- Who might be campaign leaders and/or the major donors in the community.

After four weeks of data collection, the Steier Group, the development firm we have contracted with, will compile the information and present it to me. At that time, an informed decision will be made regarding the development and implementation of a master plan. This process is important, and I encourage every parish family to participate. Your input is needed as we plan for the future of Mater Dei.
