Dear Parishioners,

You are aware that Mater Dei is conducting a planning study. By now you should have received the fact sheet about our proposed projects. As you spend time reviewing the plans, I would like to provide additional information about the planning study.

O. What is a planning study?

A. It is an assessment used to gauge support for a capital campaign that would address some, or all, of the needs identified in the fact sheet.

O. How is the study being conducted?

A. The study is being administered by the Steier Group, a Catholic development firm. They are surveying the entire parish to determine which projects you consider most urgent, and to identify potential support for a fundraising campaign.

O. Why are we doing this study and potentially starting a campaign?

- A. We recently completed a comprehensive master plan to guide us through the upcoming years. This plan will help us address our current needs, as well as take thoughtful steps to prepare for the future needs of our church. The most pressing needs identified through our master planning process are:
- The purchase of land and the building of a new church building adjacent to our current location
- A new rectory
- The purchase of the neighboring business and its conversion to office, maintenance, and storage space.
- Tearing down the current church to make room for a small gym/ parish hall annex

The planning study will measure our ability to move forward and accomplish some, or all, of those projects.

O. What do you expect of me?

A. At this time, we ask only for your feedback and your prayers. Your input and support will help us to make wise decisions as we move forward. Please note you may complete the survey online by going to steiergroup.com/survey, clicking on Mater Dei and entering the password: AveMaria.
