



FREQUENTLY *Asked Questions*

Will any of the money we raise in this campaign go to the diocese?

No. All funds raised in this capital campaign will go directly to Mater Dei and its new church.

What are the next steps?

Recently the Steier Group and Father Longua began the prep phase of the capital campaign. In this phase, the focus is on finalizing our goals, recruiting volunteers and producing campaign materials. We'll begin the public phase-asking for your financial support- with a kickoff event on Sunday, Sept. 24. The following week, everyone in the parish will receive a case statement detailing the campaign projects and a letter from Father Longua asking them to participate in the campaign.

Are we committed to staying at this location?

It is our hope and wish to stay at our current location and build here. As things unfold, we will try to make the most logical decisions. We have not ruled out any possibility, including new locations. Numerous factors go into relocation such as the bishop's desires, the feasibility of a move, the economy, etc. but for now it's in our best interest to stay at our current location.

What if my family cannot make a financial contribution?

A successful campaign requires commitment from the entire parish. Each of us needs to consider what Mater Dei means to us and our families. We need to prayerfully decided what we can do to ensure campaign success. Each family will be asked to contribute to the campaign according to their means. With commitments accepted over a three-year pledge period even a modest weekly or monthly donation will have a significant impact over the collection period. If every family makes a sacrificial three-year pledge, we'll enjoy campaign success and be well on our way to building a beautiful church for Mary.

What can I/we do right now?
