



Epiphany Blessing of Gold, Frankincense, Myrrh and Chalk On Saturday, January 6th there will be the blessing of gold, frankincense, myrrh and chalk after each Mass. This blessing will be repeated on the following Sunday, after each Mass. Bring your gold, but don't expose it; we can bless it just as well in your pocket. Blessed Chalk will be available to take to your homes along with the blessing for the Epiphany House Blessing. Father will give the blessing from the altar, which can be taken to your homes.

Blessing of Epiphany Water

On Sat., Jan. 6th after the 9:30am Mass there will be the blessing of Epiphany water. You may attend the blessing and you may bring your large bottles of water to be blessed *(please nothing smaller than a quart size)*. Epiphany water will also be available in the vestibule, until it runs out.
