(St. John Chrysostom III Class, White) Of incredible intellect, his powerful eloquence earned him the surname Chrysostom, meaning "golden mouth." With St. Athanasius, Gregory Nazienzen, and Basil, he forms the group of the four great doctors of the Eastern Church. He died in 407.

**MONDAY, JANUARY 28, St. Peter Nolasco (St. Agnes) III Class, White**

Born of noble and wealthy parents in France, St. Peter Nolasco was commissioned by our Lady to found the order of Our Lady of Mercy for the Ransom of Captives. When all the funds of the work were exhausted, the religious were bound by their rule to take the places of the prisoners with the infidels. He died in 1256.

**TUESDAY, JANUARY 29, St. Francis de Sales, III Class, White**

Born in 1567, he would be sent Chablais in France where his preaching brought back sixty thousand Calvinists to the Catholic Faith. He founded the order of the Visitation and was known for his apostolic zeal and gentle holiness. A prolific writer, his most celebrated books are the Introduction to the Devout Life and the Treatise on the Love of God. He died in 1622.

A noble Roman virgin, St. Martina suffered martyrdom during the persecution of Alexander Severus about 228.

**THURSDAY, JANUARY 31, St. John Bosco, III Class, White**

Born in 1815 and raised by a saintly mother, he would become a priest and, on account of his tremendous confidence in God, accomplish numerous works in spite of tremendous obstacles. Moved by compassion towards the young, especially of the poorer classes, he founded schools and orphanages and employed all his talents – and sense of humor – in the Christian formation of them. His charity, humility, and kindness were well-known. He died in 1888.

**FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 1, St. Ignatius (St. Brigid of Ireland) III Class, Red**

One of the finest examples of a bishop in the early Church, St. Ignatius was condemned to the wild beasts and sent to Rome in chains. On his way there, he wrote magnificent letters to the churches, exhorting obedience to the Church, and in which his great love of Christ and ardent desire for martyrdom find expression: "I am the wheat of Christ; may I be ground by the fangs of wild beasts and become a bread with no impurity." He died around 110.

The Purification is a festival of light. The blessing and procession of candles recalls the manifestation of Christ as the Light of the world, received in the temple by Simeon as God's messenger: A light of revelation to the Gentiles and a glory for Thy people Israel. It is one of the oldest, if not the oldest, of the Marian feasts.
