He was a poet as well as a commentator on Sacred Scripture, and composed hymns about the mysteries of Christ, our Lady, and the saints; he was called the 'harp of the Holy Spirit.' He died in 373 and was proclaimed a Doctor of the Church in 1920 by Benedict XV.

(Ss. Gervase & Protase)

Born in Florence in 1270, she was received by St. Philip Benzini into the order of Servites. She practiced to a rare degree the special Servite devotion to the Seven Sorrows of Our Lady. She possessed a special devotion to the Blessed Sacrament and received Communion miraculously the day of her death, the Host passing through her body to nourish her since she could neither eat nor drink.
