**MONDAY - July 15– St. Henry the Emperor Confessor - III Class White** Henry II, called the Pious, was Duke of Bavaria in 995, King of Germany in 1002, and head of the Holy Roman Empire from 1014 until 1024. He worked for the spread of religion by rebuilding churches and founding monasteries. Until the end of his life he displayed on the throne the virtues of a great saint. He died in 1024, bequeathing all his goods to the Cathedral of Bamberg.

### TUESDAY - July 16– Feria - IV Class Green (Our Lady of Mt. Carmel)

In July 16, 1251, Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock, the superior of a group of Carmelites who had come to Europe six years earlier, and placed in his hands the habit which was to be their distinctive sign. Pope Innocent IV blessed the habit and attached to it many privileges both for the members of the order and those attached to it in some way by the devout wearing of it.

### THURSDAY - July 18 -St. Camillus de Lellis, Confessor III White (Ss Symphorosa & Her Seven Sons)

Founder of the Camillians, a congregation devoted to the service of the sick, whatever their disease, state, or condition, he died in Rome on July 14, 1614. Leo XII placed all hospitals and sick people under his patronage and Pius XI declared him the protector of all nursing sisters.

### FRIDAY - July 19 - St Vincent de Paul, Confessor- III Class White

Born in France in 1581, while still young he fell into the hands of Turkish pirates who carried him to Africa. Upon his return to France, he became a parish priest and chaplain to the galley-slaves. He was entrusted by St. Francis de Sales as spiritual director to the nuns of the Visitation. In order to help poor foundlings, young girls whose virtue was exposed to danger, and others insane, invalid, or sick, he founded with St. Louis de Marillac the Congregation of the Daughters of Charity, known also as the Sisters of St. Vincent. He died in Paris in 1660. Leo XIII proclaimed him the special patron of all charitable associations.

### SATURDAY - July 20 - St. Jerome Emiliani, Confessor- III Class White (St. Margaret)

Born in Venice, he founded a congregation for the education of youth in orphanages and colleges. He opened asylums for the poor and gave them abundant alms with the help of the local nobility. After carrying victims of the plague on his shoulders to their burial place, he in turn died of the same illness in 1537.
