## WEDNESDAY - July 31 - St. Ignatius of Loyola, Confessor - III White

Born in Loyola, Spain in 1491, he first took up a military career. A serious injury confined him to a hospital, where he began reading Scripture and the lives of the saints. His faith reawakened, he realized his divine calling, laid his sword at our Lady's feet in the Benedictine Abbey at Montserrat, and set out to establish the Society of Jesus, which was raised up by Providence to combat Protestantism and resurgent paganism. He destined his followers to a militant life and, to maintain the intense spiritual life which this reguired, he organized a well-organized form of government and a masterly treatis, highly approved by the Church, known as the Spiritual Exercises, which have been the means of sanctification for thousands of souls. He died in 1556.

### THURSDAY - August 1 -St. Peter in Chains - III White

The Church venerates the chains that bound St. Peter while in prison, which symbolize the power of the keys by which the Church through Peter unbinds from sin. August 1 was chosen so as to substitute a solemnity in honor of the Prince of the Apostles for the pagan festival formerly kept in Rome to honor the emperor Augustus, from which the month has its name.

(Holy Machabees) The seven Machabees were brothers martyred with their mother in 150 B.C. Their death is accounted in 2 Mach 7.

#### FRIDAY - August 2 - St. Alphonsus Liguori, Bishop, Confessor & Doctor - III White (St. Stephen I)

A great preacher to the poor, he founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer to carry on this work. He sent his Redemptorists, as our Lord did, into the countryside and market towns and villages. He became bishop of San' Agata dei Goti, near Naples, and died in 1787. For his great works on moral theology, he has been declared a Doctor of the Church.


