MONDAY, October 7 (White) Our Lady of the Rosary, II Class (St. Mark)

It was customary in the Middle Ages for nobility to wear crowns of flowers as "chaplets." These crowns were offered to persons of distinction as a sign of reverence. Our Lady has the right to the same homage, and so the Church asks us to offer her a three-fold chaplet, or three crowns of roses, to which she has given the name Rosary. This feast was established to commemorate the victory at Lepanto over the Muslims on October 7, 1571, a favor due to the recitation of the Rosary.

TUESDAY, October 8 (White) St. Bridget, Widow, III Class (Ss. Sergius, Bacchus, Marcellus & Apuleius)

Of the royal house of Sweden, St. Bridget married Prince Ulfo, by whom she had eight children, one of whom was St. Catherine of Sweden. After the death of her husband, she would dedicate her life to religion and founded the Order of the Most Holy Savior. She died in Rome in 1373.

PONTIFICAL MASS ON SUNDAY, **OCTOBER 20, 2019 - Bishop Schneider**


