St. Catherine had been venerated at the monastery on Mt. Sinai when, in the fifteenth century, the monks discovered her body. Legend has made of her a young Christian of Alexandria (Egypt) who rejected the advances of Emperor Maximinus and routed a meeting of learned men gathered together to induce her to deny Christ. She is the patron of philosophers.

Born of noble parents, when present one day at the funeral of an illustrious man, a relative of his, he was struck by the hideous appearance of the body of one who had been so handsome. He left all and retired to the desert where he practiced penance and meditation and eventually founded the Congregation of the Sylvestrines under the Benedictine rule. He died at ninety years of age in 1267.

SATURDAY, November 30 (Red) St. Andrew, Apostle, II Class
As we are reminded by the Gospel of this Mass, St. Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, was the first Apostle called by our Lord. At Christ’s call, he left his nets straightway and followed Him to become a “fisher of men.” Little is known of St. Andrew’s subsequent apostolic career. The old accounts of his martyrdom depict him crucified on two beams fastened together in the form of an “x” and contain beautiful passages on fidelity to Christ and love of the Cross; for this reason St. Andrew has become known in Christian devotion as the Apostle of the Cross.

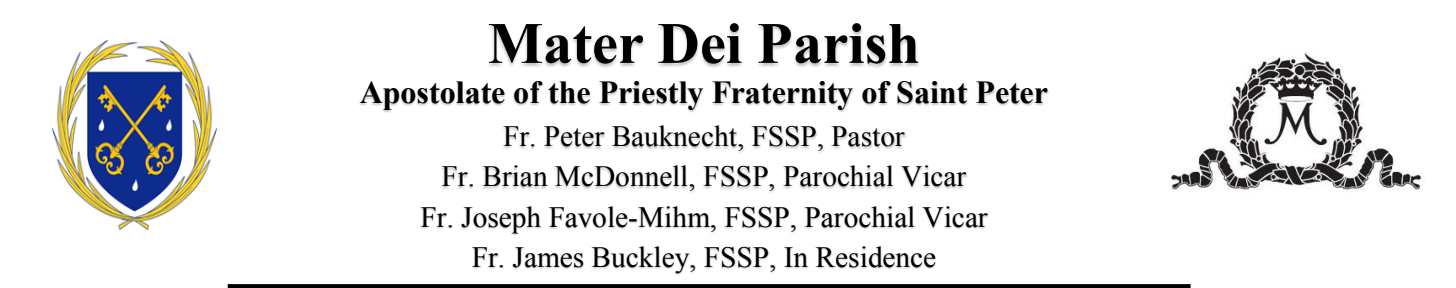
