Jan. 12th - Epiphany Blessing of Gold, Frankincense, Myrrh will be at the blessing tables in the St. Julie and St. Louis classrooms after each Mass. Blessed Chalk will be available in the vestibule, to take to your home, along with the blessing for the Epiphany House Blessing.

A Plenary Indulgence is granted to those who recite publicly the Te Deum (blue hymnal #212) on the last day of the year.
The same applies to the Veni Creator (blue hymnal # 66) on the first day of the year.
