The cathedra (chair) is the throne established where the bishop resides, hence the name cathedral given to the church where his seat is placed. Metaphorically, it represents the episcopal authority itself. The Chair of St. Peter means, therefore a memory of St. Peter's episcopate and his primacy as the head of the Church.
