Called the Apostle of the North, St. Hyacinth was born in 1185. He was received into the Dominican order by St. Dominic. In 1218, he was made superior of the mission which the saint sent to Poland; from there, he traveled through Austria, Denmark, Scotland, and Livonia, his preaching confirmed by numerous miracles. He died August 15, 1257.

Renowned as a preacher and ascetic writer, he promoted the public worship of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. He died August 19, 1690 and canonized in 1925.

Pope Eugenius III received his monastic training from St. Bernard and sought his counsel through his pontificate. A staunch defender of the faith against heresy, St. Bernard preached the second crusade against Islam. He died in 1153.
