St. Stephen of Hungary, King/Confessor, III Class

The first king of Hungary, he converted his people to the Catholic Faith. He gave Christian laws to his country, founded bishoprics, established monasteries, and organized several charitable institutions. His great zeal for the spread of the faith earned him the title of “Apostolic King” and apostle of Hungary. He died on the feast of the Assumption of Our Lady in 1538, to whom he had consecrated his kingdom.
