Monday, August 10 St. Laurence, Deacon & Martyr, II Class - Red

St. Lawrence was the first of seven deacons attached to the service of the Church in Rome under Sixtus II. When he was called to deliver up the property of the Church in his charge, he showed to his persecutors a crowd of poor people. "Here are the true treasures of the Church," he said, "they convert our alms into imperishable treasure for us." As a reward for his daring he was made to undergo torture on the grill and died on August 10, 258, a few days after the Pope.

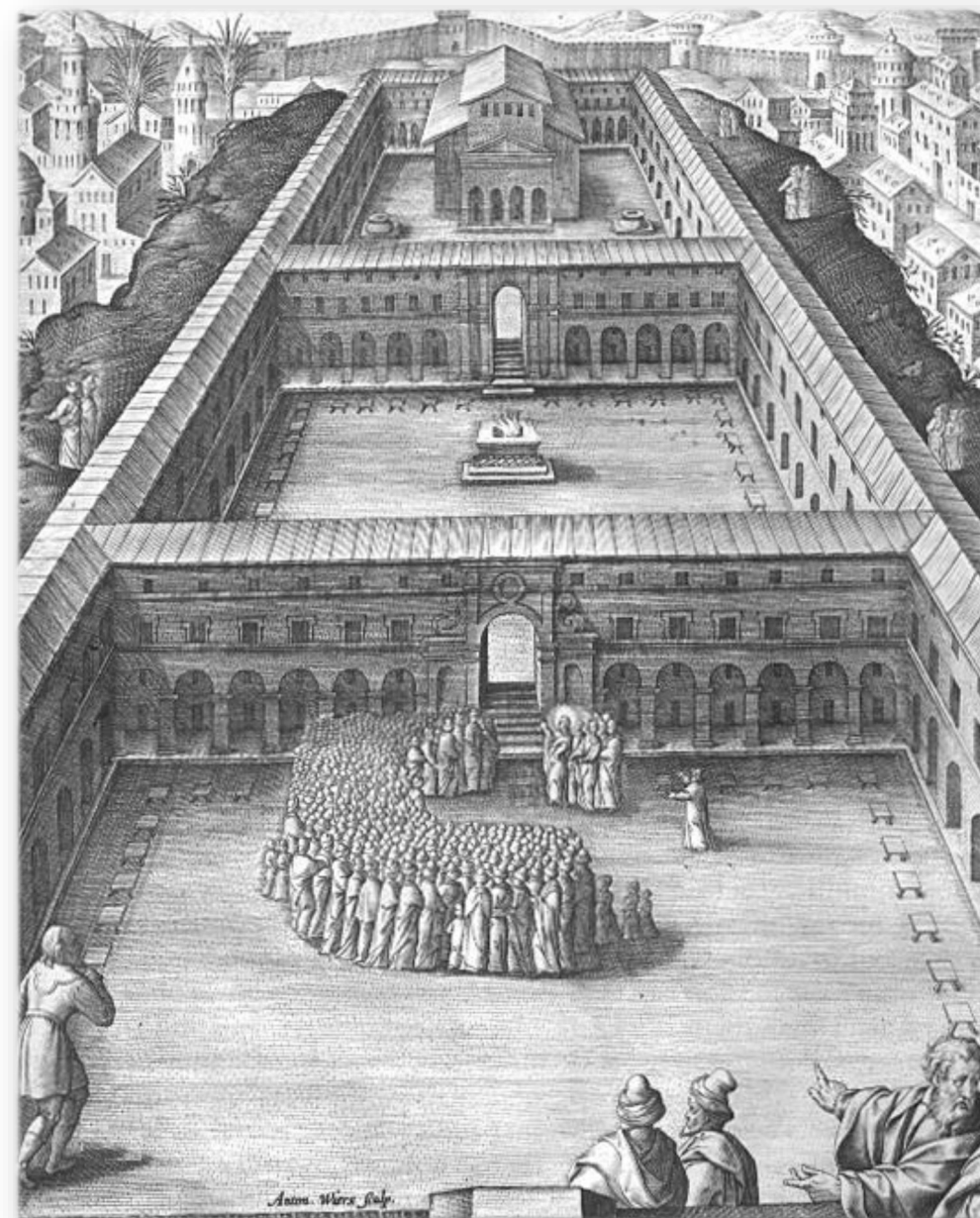
