Monday, February 1 - Red, St. Ignatius, Bishop and Martyr, III Class

One of the finest examples of a bishop in the early Church, he was condemned to the wild beasts and sent to Rome in chains. On his way there, he wrote magnificent letters to the churches, exhorting obedience to the Church, and in which his great love of Christ and ardent desire for martyrdom find expression: "I am the wheat of Christ; may I be ground by the fangs of wild beasts and become a bread with no impurity." He died around 110.

It is one of the oldest, if not the oldest, of the Marian feasts
