St. Philip followed Peter and Andrew from Bethsaida in Galilee. St. James, called the Less to distinguish him from the other Apostle James, was from Cana. He was a cousin of our Lord. The first bishop of Jerusalem, he was called upon by the High Priest to deny Christ. Upon his refusal, he was thrown down from the terrace of the temple and killed by a blow of a club.

Wednesday, May 12 - Vigil of the Ascension, II Class, White (Lesser Rogations-II Class Violet), (Ss. Nereus, Achilleus, Domitilla, & Pancras)

Nereus and Achilleus, soldiers of the Roman army, converted to the Faith and were beheaded. The Roman virgin Domitilla died in exile. Tradition holds Pancras to have been martyred at 14 years of age for refusing to sacrifice to idols. Traditionally on Low Sunday, the children of Rome would go to renew their baptismal promises at his tomb.
