### Tuesday, June 29 - SS. Peter and Paul, Apostles, I Class, Red

Veneration of the two great Apostles, Peter and Paul, finds its basis on the very foundations of the Church. They are the solid rock upon which the Church is built, for they were at the origin of her faith and will remain forever her protectors and guides. To them does Rome owe its true renown, for it was under God's providential guidance that they were led to make of the capital of the Roman empire, sanctified by their martyrdoms, the center of the Christian world, whence should radiate the teachings of the Gospel. St. Peter was martyred on a cross upside-down under Nero in 66 or 67 and buried on the hill of the Vatican. St. Paul was martyred on the Ostian way; Basilicas bearing their names stand over these sites.
