Born in 1215, he became King of France at twelve years of age and was very piously brought up by his mother, Queen Blanche of Castille. He left the reputation of being a just king, a man of prayer, entirely devoted to the business of the kingdom and interests of Christendom. He undertook two separate crusades in the Holy Land; he died in 1270 during the second crusade when an epidemic would strike his army.

After an early life full of disorders of all kinds, by the prayers of his mother, St. Monica, St. Augustine would be baptized by St. Ambrose at 33 years of age. He was a man of ardent temperament and profound intelligence and has left to posterity treatises and sermons which still remain today one of the treasures of the Church's thought. He died August 28, 430 after reigning as bishop of Hippo in northern Africa for 36 years.

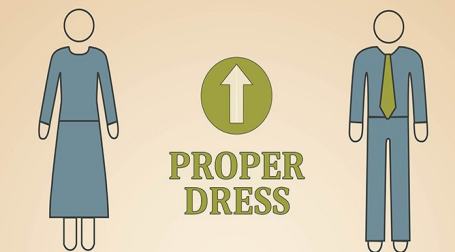
