### Thursday, September 9– St. Peter Claver, Confessor , III Class, White

Born in Spain in 1584, he would spend 27 years in unflagging devotedness to the African slaves in South America. Called the "Slave of the slaves," nearly three hundred thousand of them received baptism at his hands. He welcomed them on their arrival, instructed them, gave them alms, and nursed them in any sort of malady. St. Alphonsus Rodriguez, contemporary and canonized with St. Peter Claver, had received a revelation of the apostolic career of Peter and the incomparable glory reserved for him in heaven. St. Nicholas received his baptismal name of the holy bishop of Myra because he was born after a pilgrimage made by his parents to the tomb of the great miracle-worker. Following the example of his holy patron, although only seven years old, he fasted several times during the week. He would give up all his possessions and enter the Order of Hermits of St. Augustine. 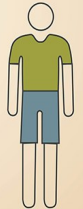
