St. Jerome, in search for a perfect form of life, lived for a time as a hermit in the Syrian desert, giving himself up to severe mortification and meditation on Scripture. He is best known for his translation of the Bible and establishing the Latin translation known as the Vulgate, which the Church adopted as her official version.. His great learning, commentaries on Scripture, and zeal against the heresies of the time earned him the title of Doctor of the Church.

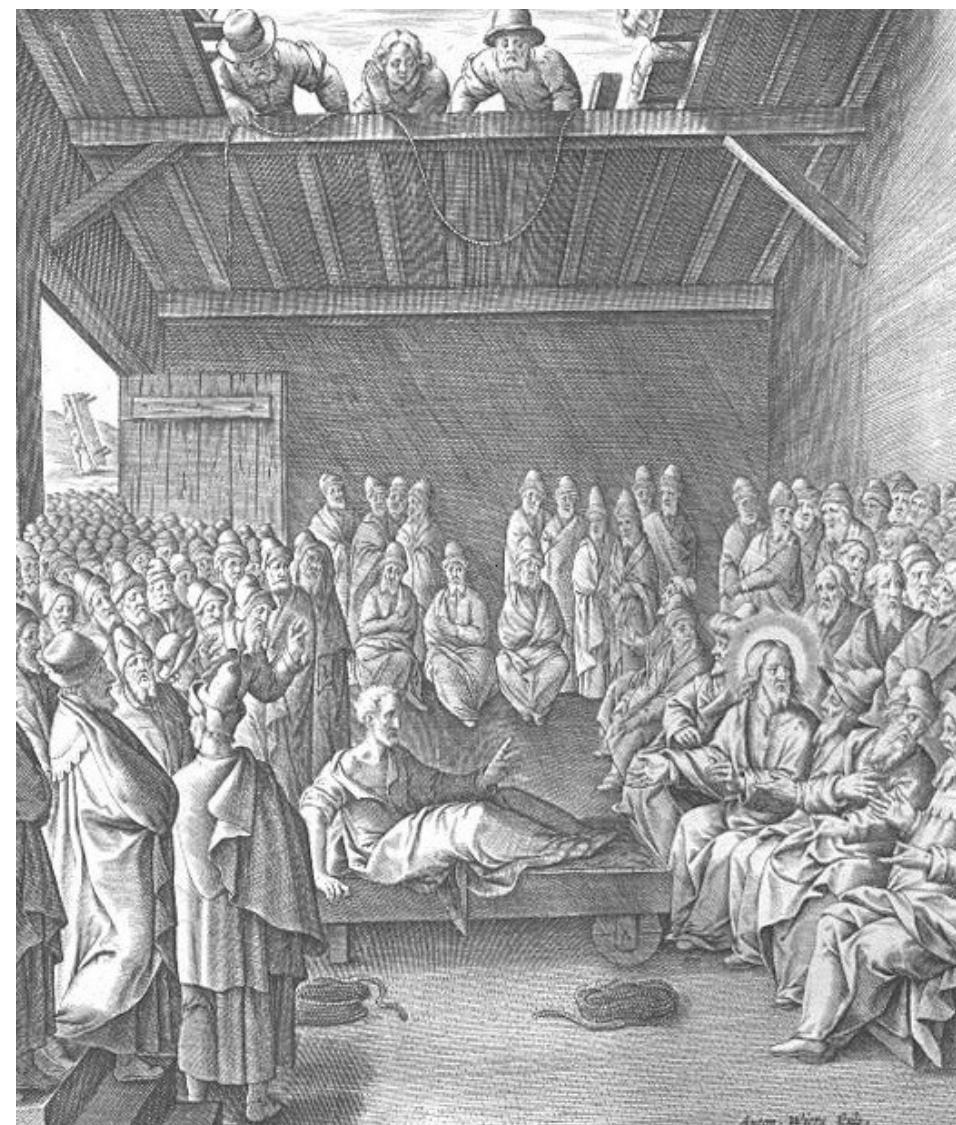
