Born in Italy in 480, Benedict's parents sent him to Rome for studies; but fleeing the city's worldliness, he sought refuge in a cave at Subiaco, where he lived for three years. The renown of his virtues soon drew people to him and he began to gather disciples; for them he founded in the mountains twelve monasteries in which was observed the monastic motto: Ora et labora, pray and work. He later founded his principal monastery at Monte-Casino and wrote his famous rule. He died March 21, 547 just after receiving Holy Communion at Mass He is the father of western monasticism.
