Tuesday, July 5- St. Anthony Mary Zaccaria, Confessor, III Class, White

Founder of the Clerks of St. Paul, later called the Barnabites from the name of their principal church in Rome, St. Anthony-Mary was a great admirer of St. Paul and was himself imbued with the teaching of the great Apostle, whom he gave to his followers as a model and patron. He also had a great devotion to the Holy Eucharist. He was an indefatigable preacher and wore himself out in this work. He died on July 5, 1539 at the age of 36. Wednesday, July 6- Feria, IV Class, Green (Comm. St. Maria Goretti, Virgin & Martyr)

Born to a peasant family in Italy, on July 6, 1902, at 12 years of age, solicited to sin, she preferred to be stabbed to death rather than lose her virginity. She died pardoning her murderer and praying for his conversion, which she obtained. She was canonized in 1950 by Pope Pius XII, with her own elderly mother and murderer in attendance. Thursday, July 7- Ss. Cyril and Methodius, Bishops and Confessors, III Class, White

Born in the early ninth century, and having studied together at Constantinople, the brothers Cyril and Methodius converted numerous souls to the Faith among the Slavs. They were consecrated bishops by Pope Adrian II. Having invented the Slavic alphabet, they translated the Scriptures and celebrated the sacred rites in that language.

Friday, July 8- St. Elizabeth of Portugal, Queen, Widow, III Class, White


