Monday, August 1 - St. Peter in Chains III Class, White (Comm. St. Paul / Holy Machabees)

The Church venerates the chains that bound St. Peter while in prison, which symbolize the power of the keys by which the Church through Peter unbinds from sin. August 1 was chosen so as to substitute a solemnity in honor of the Prince of the Apostles for the pagan festival formerly kept in Rome to honor the emperor Augustus, from which the month has its name.

For his great works on moral theology, he has been declared a Doctor of the Church.
