Leo XII placed all hospitals and sick people under his patronage and Pius XI declared him the protector of all nursing sisters. Born in France in 1581, while still young he fell into the hands of Turkish pirates who carried him to Africa. Upon his return to France, he became a parish priest and chaplain to the galley-slaves. He was entrusted by St. Francis de Sales as spiritual director to the nuns of the Visitation. In order to help poor foundlings, young girls whose virtue was exposed to danger, and others insane, invalid, or sick, he founded with St. Louis de Marillac the Congregation of the Daughters of Charity, known also as the Sisters of St. Vincent. He died in Paris in 1660. Leo XIII proclaimed him the special patron of all charitable associations.
