Monday, July 25- St. James, the Greater, Apostle, II Class, Red (Comm. of St. Christopher)

Cousin of Our Lord and brother of St. John, he was the first Apostle to suffer martyrdom, being beheaded in 42 or 43 by Herod Agrippa. Since the ninth century, Spain has claimed the honor of possessing his relics; the pilgrimage of St. James of Compostella remained famous throughout the Middle Ages.

Devotion to St. Anne is founded on the bond which united her to Mary, whose mother she is. The association of Christian Mothers have chosen her as patron saint. Veneration of St. Anne originated in the East and was propagated in the West at the time of the Crusades; its feast was instituted by Urban IV in 1378 and fixed on July 26 by Gregory XIII in 1584.

Thursday, July 28- Ss. Nazarius and Celsus, Martyrs. Victor I, Pope & Martyr, and St. Innocent I, Pope & Confessor, III Class, Red

St. Nazarius, baptized by St. Linus, in his turn baptized young Celsus. They were beheaded at Milan in 68. In 395, their bodies were discovered and in the tomb of St. Nazarius was found a phial of his blood as red as if it had been shed that very day. Also remembered is Pope St. Victor I, who fixed the date of Easter as it is now, being the Sunday after the first full moon after the vernal equinox. He was martyred in 202. And also Pope St. Innocent I, a contemporary of St. Augustine and St. Jerome, who died in 417.
