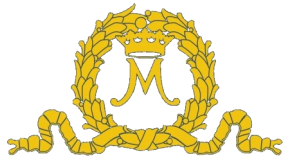

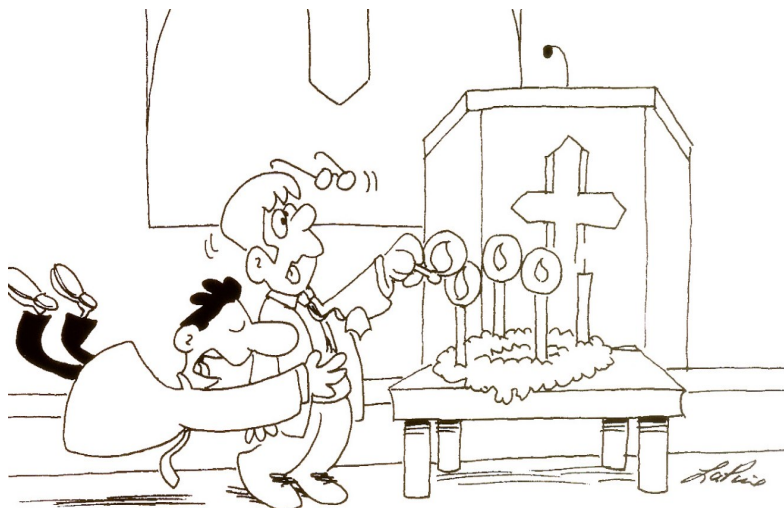
Promise 12 Rosary Makers Class and Repairs

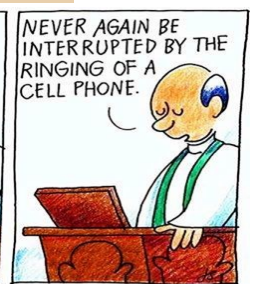
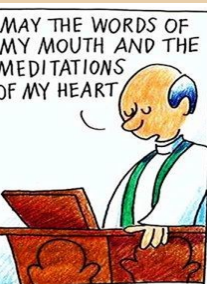
