**The Holy Face Mission - February 5-8**  
Fr. Lawrence Carney of the Diocese of Wichita, Kansas will be preaching a mission on The Holy Face. The mission will begin with his sermon at all Sunday Masses, as well as Monday thru Wednesday nights at 6pm Mass followed by a mission talk from 7-8pm. The devotions of the Holy Face of Our Lord were revealed to Sr. Mary of St. Peter (1847) and call to mind the sins which most offend God in our modern times; blasphemy and the profanation of Sunday and Holy Days of obligation. The mission talks will focus on the increased need for reverence, reparation and reversion.

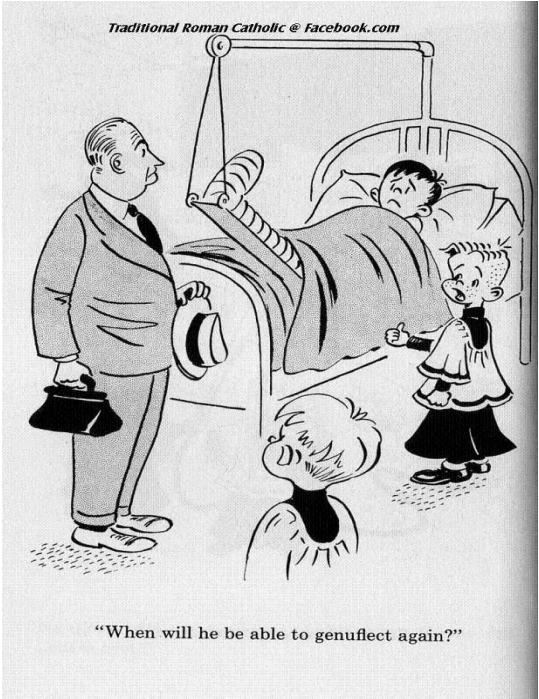


