MDYA Lenten Retreat

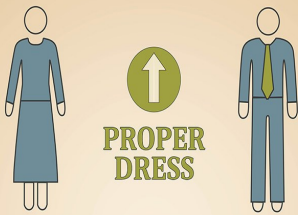
