After an early life full of disorders of all kinds, by the prayers of his mother, St. Monica, St. Augustine would be baptized by St. Ambrose at 33 years of age. He was a man of ardent temperament and profound intelligence and has left to posterity treatises and sermons which still remain today one of the treasures of the Church’s thought. He died August 28, 430 after reigning as bishop of Hippo in northern Africa for 36 years.

Born in 1586 in Lima, Peru, from her earliest years she lived solely for the love of Jesus, bearing with great patience the opposition of her family. She became a third-order Dominican and died in 1617; she is the first canonized saint of South America.
