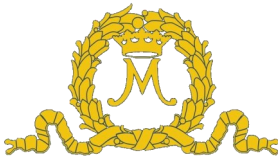

Confirmation Registration

Registrations for youth confirmands will be accepted between
October 2 - December 4. This is a hard cutoff date. All paperwork
must be completed and submitted by this date for your child to be
included in the spring Confirmation group. Youth Confirmations
are held once a year during the Vigil of Pentecost Mass. **2024
Confirmations will take place on May 18 at the 5pm Mass.**

Important Notes:

- Only Family members of registered Mater Dei parishioners may receive the Sacrament at the parish.
- Families of confirmands must be registered parishioners for at least a year.
- Only the parents or legal guardians may register a confirmand.
- Reception of the sacrament cannot be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.
- Confirmandi should be in at least the eighth grade, per Diocesan policy.
- Attendance at four priest-led Catechism classes is required; additional catechesis is the responsibility of the parents.
- There is a \$20 suggested donation.
