Monday, November 13 - St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, *Virgin*, III Class, White
Foundress of the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart, she devoted herself especially to work for the unprotected young and for the Italian immigrants in the US, founding for them schools and hospitals, and became known as their Mother. She was canonized by Pius XII in 1946 who praised her as having the meekness and humility of Christ, mistrust of self which led to boundless confidence in God, an intense union with the Heart of our Lord, and a rare intensity of her interior life that matched the extreme external activity of her existence. She died December 22, 1917 and , as a naturalized American, is considered the first saint of the United States.

Tuesday, November 14 - St. Josaphat, *Bishop & Martyr*, III Class, Red
A Catholic of the Ruthenian rite, he labored for the return of Orthodox schismatics to Rome. After being made Archbishop of Polotsk, his zeal for the cause aroused the anger of the schismatics, he was murdered by a mob in 1623. His prayer obtained the conversion of his murderers.

A Dominican of immense learning, and teacher of St. Thomas Aquinas, he was made bishop of Ratisbon and was known for his defense of the Church. He died in 1280 and was canonized and proclaimed Doctor in 1931.

Confirmation Registration

Registrations for youth confirmands will be accepted between October 2 - December 4. This is a hard cutoff date. All paperwork must be completed and submitted by this date for your child to be included in the spring Confirmation group. Youth Confirmations are held once a year during the Vigil of Pentecost Mass. 2024 Confirmations will take place on May 18 at the 5pm Mass.

Important Notes:

- Only Family members of registered Mater Dei parishioners may receive the Sacrament at the parish.
- Families of confirmands must be registered parishioners for at least a year.
- Only the parents or legal guardians may register a confirmand.
- Reception of the sacrament cannot be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.
- Confirmandi should be in at least the eighth grade, per Diocesan policy.
- Attendance at four priest-led Catechism classes is required; additional catechesis is the responsibility of the parents.
- There is a \$20 suggested donation.
