- Families of confirmands must be registered parishioners for at least a vear.
- Only the parents or legal guardians may register a confirmand. Reception of the sacrament cannot be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.
- Confirmandi should be in at least the eighth grade, per Diocesan policy.
- Attendance at four priest-led Catechism classes is required; additional cateches is the responsibility of the parents.
- There is a \$20 suggested donation.
