St. Leo the Great, overcame Attila the Hun by his eloquence, defended Papal primacy, and enriched literature with his profound discourses. He defended the Church at the Council of Chalcedon against the Christological heresies of the time, where it was exclaimed the "Peter has spoken by the mouth of Leo." He died on April 11, 461.

Saturday, April 13 - St. Hermenegild, Martyr, III Class, Red

Son of the king of the Visigoths in Spain, Hermegild married the daughter of the king of the Franks and converted to Catholicism despite the opposition of his father, who was Arian. His father in a rage threw him into a dungeon on Easter night and ordered an Arian bishop to take Hermenegild Communion. Hermenegild repelled the heretical bishop and was put to death on April 13, 586.

His father later repented died recommending the martyr's brother, Recarede, to restore Spain back to the true Faith, which was done.

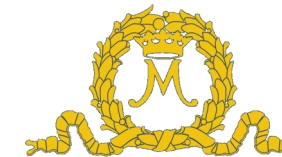

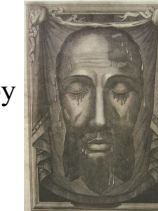
Book store modified hours on 4/10
