Monday, May 27 - St. Bede the Venerable, Confession & Doctor, III Class, White

Born at Jarrow in Northumberland, England, Bede would become a Benedictine monk and was noted as “the most observant and happiest of all monks.” One of the most learned churchmen of his time, he wrote very full commentaries on Sacred Scripture. Pope Leo XIII declared him a Doctor of the Church. St. Bede died on May 25, 735.

Wednesday, May 29 - St. Mary Magdalene of Pazzi, Virgin, III Class, White

Born at Florence to the Pazzi family in 1566, St. Mary Magdalene, at the age of 10, consecrated her virginity to Christ. She took the Carmelite habit in 1584 and, faithful to her motto To suffer, not to die, she offered any torments for the salvation of infidels and sinners. She died in 1607, her body remaining incorrupt.

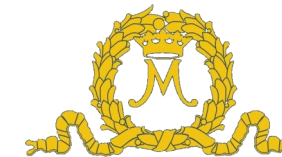
