Tuesday, June 4 - St. Francis Caracciolo, Confessor, III Class, White

The vocation of St. Francis Caracciolo is a curious one. A letter, delivered to him by mistake, informed him of the project of founding a new congregation of Minor Clerks Regular. He decided to join it and was practically its co-founder.

His life, devoted to prayer and penance, was penetrated by a burning love of God. He died in Rome in 1608.

Wednesday, June 5 - St. Boniface, Bishop & Martyr, III Class, Red

A Benedictine monk of Exeter in England, he was sent by Gregory II to preach the Gospel in Germany. His evangelization efforts were so successful that, to this day, he is still venerated as the father of the Faith in Germany. He would become the Archbishop of Mainz and later martyred in 754 during the last of his missionary journeys.

Low Mass 8:30a Shirley Ragay (RIP)

Thursday, June 6 - St. Norbert, Bishop & Confessor, III Class, White

A young knight of the imperial court in Germany, St. Norbert was miraculously called to the service of God. He at first devoted his life to preaching but would later retire to a deserted place and founded the Order of Canons Regular, known as the Norbertines. Appointed Archbishop of Magdeburg, he helped St. Bernard defeat the anti-pope Anacletus. He strenuously opposed the heresies of the time, which denied the real presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. He died in 1134.

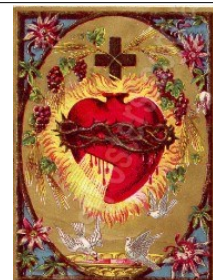
Summer Schedule Changes for 2024

Please see the following changes for the Summer Schedule:

- **Effective June 2nd**, there will be no Sung Vespers on Sundays. Sung Vespers will resume on **August 18th**.
- **Effective May 28th**, there will be no 8:30am Mass and Confessions on Tuesdays and Thursdays. 8:30am Mass & Confessions will resume on **September 3rd**.
