On the throne Margaret of Scotland gave an example of a mortified life and great charity in the service of the people under her rule. While inspiring her husband towards conversion, she brought up eight children with such piety that several of them led a life of high perfection. She was called the mother of orphans and the treasurer of the poor. She died June 16, 1093.

His sermons dealt especially with peace-making and concord, for which he was favored by the Holy Spirit with the gift of reconciling disputes.

Born in Lisbon, Portugal, in 1196, he eventually became a Franciscan and preached throughout Portugal and Italy. Both as a theologian and preacher he fought vigorously against heresy. His preaching was inspired by a love of God and of souls and had an extraordinary power of conviction; it was filled with the penetrating power of Sacred Scripture, so much so that Pope Gregory IX hailed him a "living repository of Sacred Scripture." ** Confirmation Changes **

Effective June 2024, per Diocesan policy, youth may receive the sacrament of Confirmation, at the earliest, when they are in 8th grade and Confirmation preparation for youth receiving the sacrament is a two-year process, starting at the earliest, in 7th grade. <u>Families must be registered and active (i.e. regular Mass attending) Mater Dei parishioners.</u> There will not be youth Confirmations in 2025; youth who are in 8th grade in the 2024-25 school year may prepare to receive the sacrament in 2026.

While more details about the changes will be available later this month, the office would like to inform families of important dates for youth who are preparing to be confirmed in 2026.

<u>First Saturday classes:</u> Confirmandi and at least one parent must attend First Saturday classes held from 11:30-12:30 in the parish hall. Classes will be held the months of September & November of 2024, and January-May of 2025.

<u>Half Day Retreat</u>: A half-day retreat will be held at Carmel on October 26 2024 & October 25, 2025. The retreat will run approximately 8am-noon.

Baptism Certificate: If you have a child who will be Confirmed in 2026, we suggest contacting his/her parish of baptism now to request a current baptism certificate be mailed to you (we need an original hard copy from the parish), so you will not experience any delays in getting your child registered by the August 31 deadline. Registrations can not be accepted without current baptism certificates from the parish of baptism.

** First Communion Changes **

Effective June 2024, First Holy Communions at Mater Dei will be held during select Sunday 11:30am Sung Masses and select Feast Day 7pm Sung Masses. The next available First Communion dates are September 29 and Friday, October 11 (Divine Maternity). A maximum of 10 children may receive their First Communion at any given Mass (unless they are enrolled in the First Communion class who receives on the Feast of Corpus Christi).

Children must be minimally age 7 and in second grade by the age of reception, and families must be registered and active parishioners for at least one year. Children turning age 7 and in second grade between 6/30/2024-6/30/2026 may receive their First Communion with only one year of preparation. The registration process is also being updated.
