## Wednesday, July 31 - St. Ignatius Loyola, Confessor, III Class, White

Born in Loyola, Spain in 1491, he first took up a military career. A serious injury confined him to a hospital, where he began reading Scripture and the lives of the saints. His faith reawakened, he realized his divine calling, laid his sword at our Lady's feet in the Benedictine Abbey at Montserrat, and set out to establish the Society of Jesus, which was raised up by Providence to combat Protestantism and resurgent paganism. He destined his followers to a militant life and, to maintain the intense spiritual life which this required, he organized a well-organized form of government and a masterly treatis, highly approved by the Church, known as the Spiritual Exercises, which have been the means of sanctification for thousands of souls. He died in 1556.

#### Thursday, August 1 - St. Peter in Chains, III Class, White

The Church venerates the chains that bound St. Peter while in prison, which symbolize the power of the keys by which the Church through Peter unbinds from sin. August 1 was chosen so as to substitute a solemnity in honor of the Prince of the Apostles for the pagan festival formerly kept in Rome to honor the emperor Augustus, from which the month has its name.



## \*\* First Communion Changes (Fully Updated) \*\*

## Effective July 2024:

Mater Dei will be transitioning to a two-year preparation period for First Communion.

- Those who intend to receive First Communion in 2024 should contact the office as soon as possible.
- Those who intend to receive in 2025 or 2026 will need to register between August 1 and December 13, 2024.
- Those who intend to receive in 2027 will be required to register two years in advance of the desired First

Communion date. The full two-year preparation requirement will come into effect then.

A newly issued baptism certificate will be required for

Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the age of reception, and families must be registered and active parishioners of at least one year.

Reception of the sacrament cannot be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.

For families utilizing the Homeschool Preparation option, First Holy Communions at Mater Dei will be held during select Sunday 11:30am Sung Masses and select Feast Day 7pm Sung

The remaining 2024 dates for First Communions are September 29 & Friday, October 11; (Divine Maternity)

A maximum of 10 children may receive their First Communion at any given Mass.

The parish also provides a catechism class option for secondgraders to enroll in from October - May, in which they receive the Sacrament on the Feast of Corpus Christi.
