Monday, September 2 - St. Stephen of Hungary, King & Confessor, III Class, White

The first king of Hungary, he converted his people to the Catholic Faith. He gave Christian laws to his country, founded bishoprics, established monasteries, and organized several charitable institutions. His great zeal for the spread of the faith earned him the title of "Apostolic King" and apostle of Hungary. He died on the feast of the Assumption of Our Lady in 1538, to whom he had consecrated his kingdom.

Tuesday, September 3 - St. Pius X, Pope & Confessor, III Class, White

Joseph Sarto was born at Riese in Venetia on June 2, 1835. He was successively curate, pastor, bishop of Mantua, patriarch of Venice, and finally elected Pope on August 4, 1903. As the chief pastor of the Church he realized to the full the value of the liturgy as the prayer of the Church and spared no effort to propagate the practice of frequent and daily Communion. In his great encyclical Pascendi, he exposed and condemned the modernist heresy with force and clarity (1907). He died August 20, 1914 and was canonized in 1954 by Pius XII.

First Communion Class Enrollment

Mater Dei will sponsor a parish catechism class on Monday afternoons, 10/21/2024 - 6/15/2025, for students who wish to receive the sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion during the 2024-25 school year. The First Communion Mass for class students will be on the Feast of Corpus Christi, June 19, 2025. First Confession will take place prior to First Communion on a date determined by the class instructor.

Candidates must be at least 7 years old and in the second grade by June 19, 2025, to be able to enroll in the class. Candidates may only be enrolled by families that have been registered parishioners at Mater Dei for at least one year.

Enrollment Process

Enrollment for the class will be available through the Mater Dei office from September 2 until October 4. To Enroll, download the required form at the link below, then fill it out and email, mail or drop-off the completed form to the parish office: <https://materdeiparish.com/1stcommunion-class-reg-form>. Only the parents or legal guardians of the child may register their student for the class. There is a \$15 suggested donation per child to cover the cost of the books, with a maximum of \$25 per family.

Reminder- There is a second Mass on First Saturday, Sept. 7th at 10:00AM.

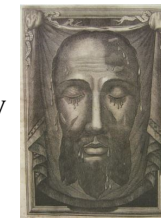
First Saturday Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary we make reparation for these five types of offenses:

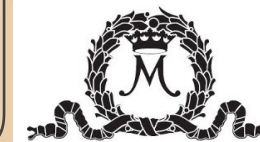
