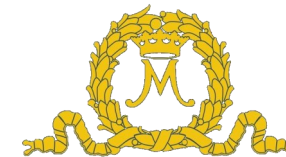

Monday, September 16 - Ss. Cornelius, Pope & Cyprian, Bishop, Martyrs, III Class, Red

Pope Cornelius, after a pontificate of two years troubled by a schism of the first anti-pope, Novatian, died in exile in 253.

St. Cyprian, a former lawyer, converted and became bishop of Carthage in northern Africa. He loved the Church ardently and fought and suffered for her. In the thick of persecution he encouraged the faithful to face martyrdom and was himself beheaded in 258 on the day Pope Cornelius' relics were transferred to Rome.

St. Matthew was a tax collector for the Romans and so his profession was hateful to the Jews because it reminded them of their subjection, and he was regarded as a typical sinner by the Pharisees. Called by our Lord, he would leave all and follow Him.

St. Matthew was the first to put down in writing our Lord's teaching and the account of His life, writing his Gospel in Aramaic, the language our Lord spoke Himself. He would suffer martyrdom as did the other Apostles.

First Communion Class Enrollment

Mater Dei will sponsor a parish catechism class on Monday afternoons, 10/21/2024 - 6/15/2025, for students who wish to receive the sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion during the 2024-25 school year. The First Communion Mass for class students will be on the Feast of Corpus Christi, June 19, 2025. First Confession will take place prior to First Communion on a date determined by the class instructor.

Candidates must be at least 7 years old and in the second grade by June 19, 2025, to be able to enroll in the class. Candidates may only be enrolled by families that have been registered parishioners at Mater Dei for at least one year.

Enrollment Process

Enrollment for the class will be available through the Mater Dei office from September 2 until October 4. To Enroll, download the required form at the link below, then fill it out and email, mail or drop-off the completed form to the parish office: <https://materdeiparish.com/1stcommunion-class-reg-form>. Only the parents or legal guardians of the child may register their student for the class. There is a \$15 suggested donation per child to cover the cost of the books, with a maximum of \$25 per family.

Baptism Certificates

A newly issued baptism certificate must be provided to the parish office by December 13, 2024, for every student that is confirmed for class attendance.

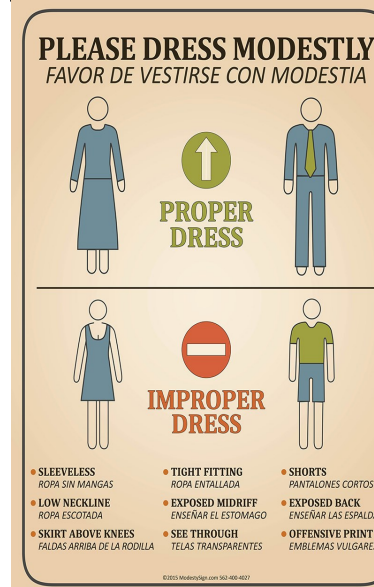
