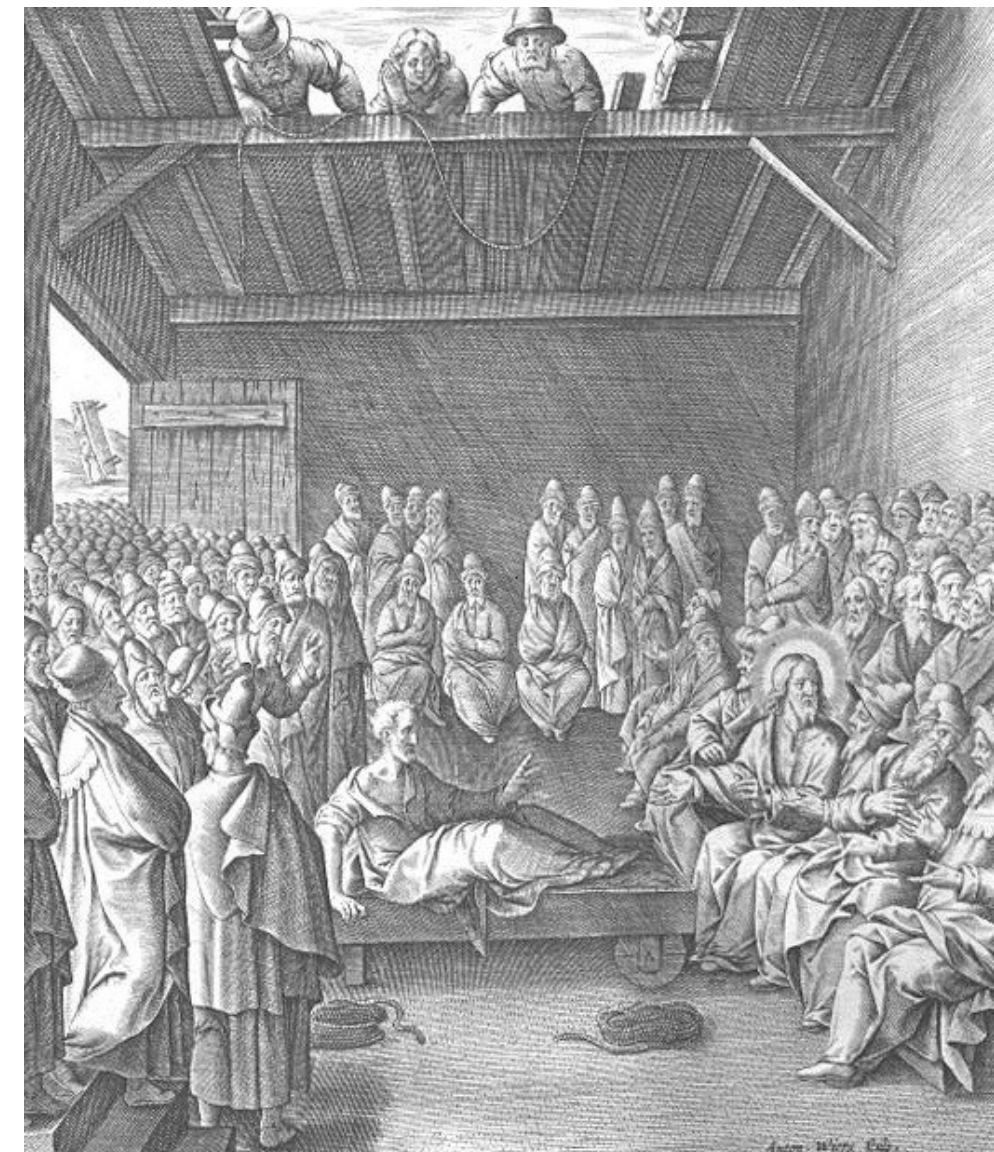

Taken prisoner by the Iroquois tribe, between 1642 and 1649 they were put to atrocious tortures, which they bore for the love of God. They were canonized by Pius XI.

Duke of Bohemia, he succeeded his father at 18 years of age, and without regard for the opposition which he aroused, he did all in his power to hasten the conversion of his country, which was still pagan, helping the German missionaries, himself giving an example of a devout life and of great Christian charity. He was martyred by his pagan brother on September 28, 929, as he was entering a church. St. Wenceslaus is the national hero and patron of Czechoslovakia.

First Communion Class Enrollment

Mater Dei will sponsor a parish catechism class on Monday afternoons, 10/21/2024 - 6/15/2025, for students who wish to receive the sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion during the 2024-25 school year. The First Communion Mass for class students will be on the Feast of Corpus Christi, June 19, 2025. First Confession will take place prior to First Communion on a date determined by the class instructor.

Candidates must be at least 7 years old and in the second grade by June 19, 2025, to be able to enroll in the class. Candidates may only be enrolled by families that have been registered parishioners at Mater Dei for at least one year.

Enrollment Process

Enrollment for the class will be available through the Mater Dei office from September 2 until October 4. To Enroll, download the required form at the link below, then fill it out and email, mail or drop-off the completed form to the parish office: <https://materdeiparish.com/1stcommunion-class-reg-form>. Only the parents or legal guardians of the child may register their student for the class. There is a \$15 suggested donation per child to cover the cost of the books, with a maximum of \$25 per family.

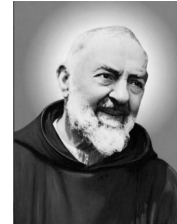
Baptism Certificates
