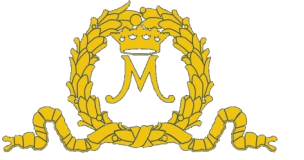

Monday, November 11 - St. Martin of Tours, Bishop & Confessor, III Class, White

Born in Pannonia, he came to Gaul (France) as a soldier. At 18, he was baptized, became a disciple of St. Hilary of Portiers, built the first monastery in Gaul, and was later made bishop of Tours, where he built another abbey. He died November 8. 397, his tomb becoming famous through many miracles and attracting large pilgrimages. He is the first bishop honored by the Church in the West.

A Catholic of the Ruthenian rite, he labored for the return of Orthodox schismatics to Rome. After being made Archbishop of Polotsk, his zeal for the cause aroused the anger of the schismatics, he was murdered by a mob in 1623. His prayer obtained the conversion of his murderers.

**** Immaculate Conception, December 9th ****

Per the Holy See, The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, A Holy Day of Obligation, has been transferred to **Monday, December 9th**. Attending Mass on Sunday on November 8th, WILL NOT fulfill the Holy Day Obligation of the Immaculate Conception. The full Dec. 9th Mass schedule will be coming out in the next couple of weeks.

First Communion Registration

Mater Dei is transitioning to a **two-year preparation period** for First Communion.

- Those who intend to receive in 2025 or 2026 will need to register by **December 13, 2024**.
- Those who intend to receive in 2027 will be required to register two years in advance of the desired First Communion date. Registration will open in 2025. The full two-year preparation requirement will come into effect then. Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the time of reception, and families must be registered and active parishioners of at least one year. A newly issued baptism certificate will be required for registration. Reception of the sacrament cannot be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese.

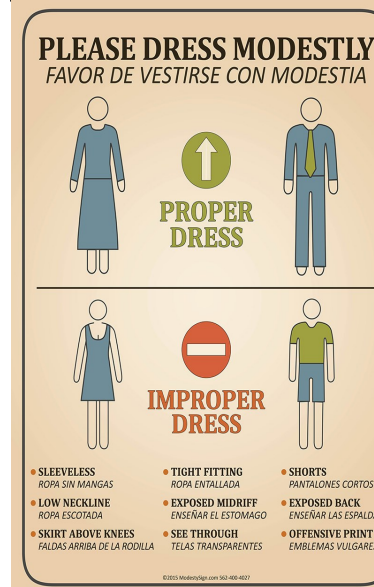
