Monday, January 6 - The Epiphany of the Lord, I Class, White

The word Epiphany means manifestation. The Church in the Mass over the next two weeks commemorates a triple manifestation of Christ: today, to the Magi who represent the Gentiles, and by whose gifts the Child is honored as King (gold) and High Priest (frankincense) who will redeem man from sin by way of His death (myrrh); on January 13, in His Baptism, when the voice from Heaven declared: "This is My beloved Son"; and on the second Sunday after the Epiphany in the miracle of changing water into wine at Cana.



Sacraments at Mater Dei

Baptism - Please allow 1 month's notice for the Sacrament of Baptism. Parents must be registered parishioners of Mater Dei. For more information, please contact secretary@materdeiparish.com

First Holy Communion - Per diocesan policy, Mater Dei is transitioning to a two-year preparation period for First Holy Communion. Children must also be minimally age 7, and in second grade when they make their First Communion. Parents and children must be registered parishioners of Mater Dei, however, reception of the Sacrament can't be guaranteed for those who reside outside of the Dallas Diocese. Parents may choose to use the homeschool program, or the classroom program. A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration (hard copy with the parish seal), followed by submission of the online registration form. Confirmation - For more information, please contact: secretary@materdeiparish.com

Marriage - Contact the parish office to meet with one of the parish priests a minimum of six months prior to proposed date; preparation program required. Either the bride or groom must have a domicile in the Dallas Diocese and be a parishioner at Mater Dei in order to have a wedding ceremony at the parish.
