Passion of Luke Music meditation

All are invited to attend *St. Luke's Passion* on **Saturday, April 12 at 3:00 PM** in the Mater Dei chapel. This sacred music concert is a meditation on the Passion and Death of Jesus Christ and sets 82 verses of St. Luke's Passion narrative from the Latin Vulgate to music for choir and string quartet. The piece requires about 90 minutes to perform and covers the Passion account from Jesus' entry into Gethsemane until just before Joseph of Arimathea seeks the Body of Jesus from Pilate. Programs will be provided with both the Latin text and the English translation.

First Saturday Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary we make reparation for these five types of offenses:

1. Blasphemies against her Immaculate Conception.
2. Blasphemies against her Perpetual Virginity.
3. Blasphemies against her Divine Maternity and refusals to recognize her as our Mother.
4. Blasphemies of those who publicly seek to sow in the hearts of children indifference or scorn, or even hatred of this Immaculate Mother.
5. Offenses of those who outrage her directly in her holy images.

Sacraments at Mater Dei

For Mater Dei Parishioners who have been registered and active (Sunday Mass attending) for at least one year.

Baptism - Please allow 1 month's notice for the Sacrament of Baptism. For more information, please email the office.

First Holy Communion - There is a two-year formation period which begins at the time of registration. Children must be minimally age 7 and in 2nd grade by the age of reception. Parents may choose to catechize their child at home, or enroll him/her in the parish First Confession/ Communion catechism class. * **A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.**

Confirmation - Youth (7th - 12th grade): There is a two-year formation period. Registration will begin in the summer. Adults: Email the office for more information. A newly issued baptism certificate is required for registration.

Marriage - Contact the parish office to meet with one of the parish priests a minimum of six months prior to proposed date; preparation program required. Either the bride or groom must have a domicile in the Dallas Diocese and be a parishioner at Mater Dei in order to have a wedding ceremony at the parish.
